Global Issues Problem Solving Team Adult Division

Evaluation was performed by team of three evaluators with determination of places by total score.

Global Issues Problem Solving Team Junior Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which teams would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 5 in first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 120 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 5 booklets in PCA advanced to Final Round where a team of four evaluators performed an evaluation collaboratively to determine placement. Ranks 6-10 were determined and awarded through PCA.

Global Issues Problem Solving Team Middle Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which teams would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 3 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 120 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 5 booklets in PCA advanced to Final Round where a team of four evaluators performed an evaluation collaboratively to determine placement. Ranks 6-10 were determined and awarded through PCA.

Global Issues Problem Solving Team Senior Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which teams would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 4 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 130 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 5 booklets in PCA advanced to Final Round where a team of four evaluators performed an evaluation collaboratively to determine placement. Ranks 6-10 were determined and awarded through PCA.

Global Issues Problem Solving Individual Junior Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which individuals would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 4 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 115 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 5 booklets in PCA were awarded 1st-5th place.

Global Issues Problem Solving Individual Middle Division

Each booklet received two initial evaluations to determine which individuals would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 3 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 120 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 5 booklets in PCA were awarded 1st-5th place.

Global Issues Problem Solving Individual Senior Division

Each booklet received two initial evaluations to determine which individuals would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 3 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 115 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 5 booklets in PCA were awarded 1st-5th place.

MAGIC Adult Division

Evaluation was performed by team of three evaluators with determination of places by total score.

MAGIC Junior Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which individuals would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 3 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 112 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 3 booklets in PCA were awarded 1st-3rd place.

MAGIC Middle Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which individuals would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 3 in the first round evaluations and/or a minimum score of 125 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 3 booklets in PCA were awarded 1st-3rd place.

MAGIC Senior Division

Each booklet received two first round evaluations to determine which individuals would advance to the Paired Comparison Analysis (PCA). Booklets with a total rank of 3 in the first round evaluation and/or a minimum score of 110 by at least one evaluator advanced to PCA. The top 3 booklets in PCA were awarded 1st-3rd place.
