General Competition Information

- Three divisions: Junior, Middle, and Senior
- ScP competitors research Biosecurity in preparation for IC.
- No later than May 9th, all ScP competitors will receive via email from their Affiliate Director with precise topic specific instructions about the story that they will create.

Performance Guidelines

Scenario Performance includes the following:

- Each performer will have 4-5 minutes to entertain an audience with his/her story.
- The performance will include only voice and hand movements of the competitor; props, physical “acting” and/or background are not permitted.
- Students may reference 10 (4x6 inch) cue cards.
- Performances will be video-taped for evaluation and promotional purposes.

Evaluation

Purpose of Scenario Performance evaluation

The primary purpose of Scenario Performance evaluation is to provide students with feedback that allows them to develop and improve their creative storytelling skills. Skill improvement is the most important aspect of evaluation. A secondary purpose of evaluation is to provide a fair, consistent, and reliable method for comparing performances in competition.

Scenario Performance Evaluation at IC

- Each performance is evaluated by three evaluators.
- Scoring is done during the live performance, and evaluators may also confer later while reviewing taped presentations recorded during the competition.
- The top-scoring scenario performance from each evaluator is awarded a rank of “1.” The second highest receives a “2,” and so on.
- The top performer in each division is determined by rank.
