The International Office of FPS mentors coaches in regions new to FPS, as well as coaches who want to participate in a component their Affiliate Program does not offer. All materials and evaluations are provided in English. Student work must be submitted in English (translation must occur prior to submission).

- **Community Problem Solving – CmPS**
 - Individual
 - Team (unlimited number)
- **Global Issues Problem Solving – GIPS**
 - Individual
 - Team (up to 4 members)
- **Scenario Writing – SW**
 - Individual
- **Scenario Performance – ScP**
 - Individual

DIVISIONS: USA grade equivalent

- **Junior (grades 4-6)**
- **Middle (grades 7-9)**
- **Senior (grades 10-12)**
- **Adult (GIPS team only)**

PROGRAM MATERIALS:

- Provided after paid registration
- Includes all information necessary to coach component(s)
- May be used by a teacher/coach with any number of teams or classes

Start-Up/Coach Fee: Mentored Coach Annual Fee \$50

All coaches must pay this fee before a registration for any component can be submitted. This fee allows a coach to register in any component(s) with any number of teams or individuals.

Components/Registration:

Once a registration with payment is received, the following items will be provided:

1. Program Materials for selected component(s) which contains specific method of evaluation/feedback for that particular component
2. Assigned mentor contact details
3. Calendar of annual deadlines and events
4. FPSPI Association supplemental materials

Component Registration Fees:

1. GIPS Team (1) = Registration fee of \$125
 - Additional Registration fee for Affiliate Bowl Competition
2. GIPS Individual (1) = Registration fee of \$100
3. CmPS team or individual = Registration fee \$100
 - Additional fee for CmPS projects submitted to International Conference
4. SW = Registration fee \$50
 - Additional fee for Scenarios that qualify for International Scenario Writing Competition
5. ScP = Registration fee \$40

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Evaluation and feedback:

- Evaluation is provided using rubric based assessment/feedback and is performed by certified International evaluator.
- GIPS - Each registered team and/or individual receives evaluation with feedback for three problems (2 Practice Problems and Qualifying Problem).
- CmPS evaluation includes Progress Report feedback and assessment of final project.
- SW evaluation provides assessment and feedback for one (1) scenario.
- ScP evaluation includes assessment and feedback for one presentation.
- Teams and Individuals may advance to higher levels dependent on quality of work and recommendation of evaluator and mentor. Additional fees will apply according to level of competition (Affiliate Competition, International Competition).
